People: We come to find nourishment. We come to be rooted in love.

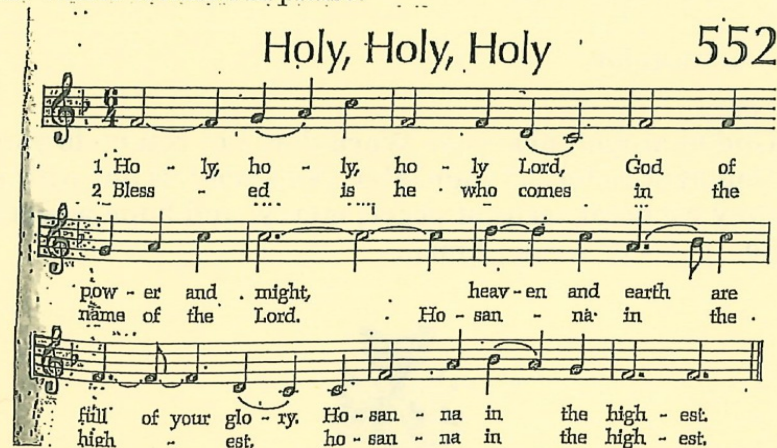
The Great Thanksgiving (Sung) (P - Cantor / C - Congregation)

The Lord's Prayer

Words of Institution

Pastor: We remember that on the night he was betrayed, Jesus took bread. When he had given thanks, he broke it and said: "This is my body, broken for you. Do this in remembrance of me." In the same way, after supper, he took the cup, saying: "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, poured out for the forgiveness of sins. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me." Great is the mystery of faith:

People: Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again.

Prayer of Consecration

Pastor: Pour out your Holy Spirit upon us and upon these gifts of bread and cup.

People: Make us good soil, O God. By this meal, nourish us to bear fruit that transforms the world. Amen.

Sharing of the Elements

Pastor: The bread we break and the cup we bless are our communion in Christ. The gifts of God for the people of God.

People: Thanks be to God.

Prayer After Communion

Pastor: Let us pray.

People: God of abundance, your Word does not return to you empty. You have fed us at your table. Now send us out with joy. May we plant seeds of peace, mercy, and hope wherever we go. In Jesus' name, Amen.
