Bedding, personal toiletries and flashlight

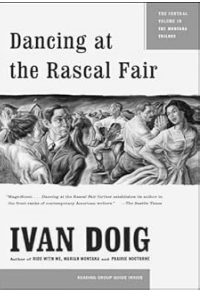

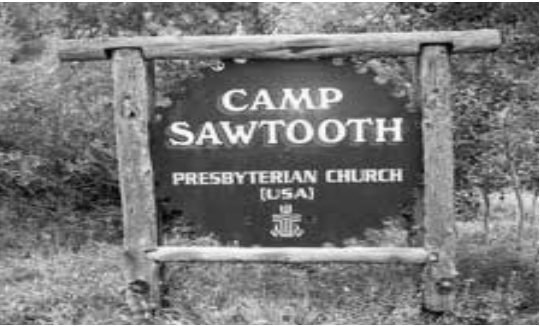
